ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

The operations at Calder Industrial Materials Ltd. include: -

- The cold rolling and slitting of lead to produce lead sheet and flashing to BS EN 12588:1999 specification, for sale to the building industry.
- The sale of a range of purchased products, specific to the metal roofing trade, chosen to complement the lead sheet and flashing materials.
- The design, manufacture and installation of Lead and Lead Alloy products to customer's requirements and applicable regulatory requirements using methods including melting, casting, rolling, extruding, forging and machining techniques.

The company operates an environmental management system to ISO 14001:2004.

This management system will address all the following aspects to ensure we can achieve a continuous improvement in the environmental field: -

- Control of information to ensure it is correct and up to date.
- Regularly review relevant legislation and other requirements to ensure we comply.
- Conduct regular briefing sessions to inform the employees of our environmental objectives.
- Promote environmental awareness and seek suggestions for improvement.
- Operate in a responsible manner to prevent pollution.
